Sharmagne spends time between her home in the Hollywood Hills, in Southern California and her fly fishing lodge on the Stillaguamish River in the Pacific Northwest. She tours the United States, Canada, and England as a performance poet. She has published four collections of poetry *Unsung Songs* (2003), *Silver Tears and Time* (2005) *Contingencies* (2008) and *La Kalima* (2010). Sharmagne is co author of a book on motion picture design, *Designing Movies: Portrait of a Hollywood Artist* (2005).

Rebecca Titus is poet and photographer from Baltimore, Maryland. She has received the Kratz Fellowship for Creative Writing and the Spencer Award for Fine Art from Goucher College. She is currently spending a month in Washington State to experience Native American culture through the Canoe Journey, Seattle's poetry scene, and the wild, natural landscape of the Pacific Northwest. She will graduate this December with a BA in Creative Writing and a minor in Photography.

The fun continues into fall with bimonthly readings and a planned poetry slam competition.
